SIWA Social

Welfare

Since its inception in 1962, SIWA has been serving Korea's most disadvantaged communities through charitable contributions and volunteer efforts.

In 2015, SIWA also launched a Philanthropy Project to commit to a more strategic and long-term giving plan. Our objectives are: address a specific social issue, seek out its root cause, and find a solution. The first issue was multicultural students' education. Currently, we are proud to support the social and economic independence of unwed mothers.

SIWA Charity Gala

The annual Charity Gala is SIWA's second largest fundraiser, after the Bazaar. The Charity Gala provides a chance for SIWA members, their friends and family, to celebrate together with dinner, dancing, raffles and entertainment while raising money for local charities.

SIWA & Diplomatic Community Bazaar

The Bazaar is the largest international fundraising event in Seoul. Over KRW 3 billion has been raised since the first Bazaar in 1962. A cultural exchange experience, it brings together the international and Korean communities for a day of exploring global foods, handicrafts and much more.

SIWA Interest Groups offer events throughout the year that are exclusive to SIWA Members.

Book Club

Casual monthly gatherings enable members with different backgrounds to share their thoughts and cultures, allowing a deeper understanding of the selected book.



Community Service

Members can give back to the host community by volunteering their time at SIWA-supported organizations, such as a soup kitchen or an infant orphanage.

Cultural Connection

This program aims to foster better understanding and appreciation of the world's cultures through performances, cuisine and conversation.



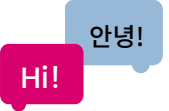
International Culinary Exchange
